		(A Hymn of Praise: Triumph Over the Wicked)
Verse 1		(In that day you will say,) "O, Lord, Thou art my God."
		I will exalt thee, I will praise thy name.
	(For)	Thou hast done wonderful things, Thy counsels of old are faithfulness and truth.
Verse 2	(For)	Thou hast made of a city, an heap, Thou hast made of a defended city, a ruin.
		Thou hast made it so palaces of strangers (heathen mansions) will no longer be (form) cities, Thou hast made it so that they shall never be (re)built!
Verse 3		Therefore:
		The strong (powerful) people shall glorify <i>thee</i> , The city (A community) of the terrible (tyrannous) nations shall fear <i>thee</i> .
Verse 4	(For)	Thou hast been a strength (refuge) to the poor, Thou hast been a strength (shelter) to the needy in their distress.
		Thou hast been a refuge <sub>(covert)</sub> from the storm, Thou hast been a shadow <sub>(shade)</sub> from the heat.
		When the blast(s) of the terrible ones (tyrants) was as a storm against the wall (or like scorching heat in the desert):
Verse 5		Thou didst bring down (quell) the noise (onslaughts) of strangers (heathens), Thou didst bring down (subdue the power of) the terrible ones (tyrants), aS (someone would do to bring down) (burning) heat with the shadow (shade) of a cloud.

Verse 6	(And)	In This Mountain shall the Lord of Hosts, make unto all people, a feast of fat things (sumptuous feast):
		A feast of fat things full of marrow, (Delicacies) A feast of wines on the lees, well refined. (Aged wine - No Dregs)
		(See Rev. 19:7-9 – "Marriage Supper of the Lamb" – This feast will take place at or near the time of the Second Coming - See D&C 58:9-11, Matt. 22:2-14, Luke 14:16- 24 - UI pg. 227)
Verse 7	(And)	In This Mountain he will destroy:
Verse 8	(and)	The face of the covering (veil) cast over all people, The (shroud) that is spread over all nations; (by) swallowing up death in victory.
	(and)	(My Lord), Will:
	(and the)	Wipe away tears from off all faces, Take away the rebuke of his people from off all the earth, for the Lord hath spoken it.
Verse 9		And it shall be said in that day:
		A Lo, this is our God, B We have waited for him, and he will save us!
	(and)	A This is the Lord, B We have waited for him, and we will be glad and rejoice in his salvation!
Verse 10	(For)	In This Mountain shall the hand of the Lord rest:
	(and)	Moab (prideful entities) shall be trodden down under him, Even as straw is trodden down for the dunghill.
Verse 11	(And)	He shall spread forth his hands in the midst of them, Even as he that swimmeth spreadeth forth his hands to swim.
	(and)	He shall bring down their pride, He shall bring down the spoils of their hands.
Verse 12	(And)	(Your highly walled, fortifications):
	(and)	He shall bring down, <sub>(and)</sub> lay low, He shall bring to the ground, even to the dust.
